

# OCBC-Great Eastern Pickleball Series at The Kallang

## 1. Background

The OCBC-Great Eastern Pickleball Series (the “**Series**”) is organised by the OCBC Group and The Kallang Group Pte. Ltd. (and its collaborators) (collectively referred to as the “**Organisers**” with its respective parent companies, subsidiaries, affiliates). The Learn-to-Play Sessions (each a “**Session** and collectively, the “**Sessions**”), as part of the Series, offer clinics and social games designed for beginners and recreational players to promote inclusive opportunities for participation, social interaction, and healthy living.

## 2. Session Periods and Categories

### 2.1. For the period between

- (a) 24 - 25 April 2026
- (b) 15 - 16 May 2026
- (c) 21 - 22 August 2026
- (d) 4 – 5 September 2026

This category is open to individuals aged 13 to 20 years old only, as of registration date.

2.1.3. Multi-generation Workshop:

\$28 per group of three (3)

Up to 36 participants per Session (i.e., 1) 6 groups

To meet the Multi-Generation requirement, your group should include 3 participants from at least 2 of the following generations registered together.

- Child aged 7 years and above
- Adult aged 21 years and above
- Senior aged 60 years and above

### **3. Terms and Conditions**

#### **General**

- 3.1. The Sessions are suitable for players with no prior experience in playing pickleball.
- 3.2. Registration will be on a first come, first served basis.
- 3.3. Participants under 18 at the time of registration must obtain parental or guardian consent and cannot register on their own.
- 3.4. Participants registering without parental consent must be 18 years old on the official registration launch date.
- 3.5. The fees stated are inclusive of the use of necessary equipment during a Session (paddles and balls). Participants are to return all equipment after the Session.
- 3.6. Appropriate sports attire and proper footwear (no slippers and sandals) are mandatory at all times to ensure safety for all players.
- 3.7. All activities must be carried out strictly within designated court areas and in accordance with the intended purpose of the Sessions.
- 3.8. Participants are responsible for their own health and safety. The Organisers will not be liable for any injuries sustained during a Session.
- 3.9. All participants must complete the indemnity form on <https://www.thekallang.com.sg/announcement/new-electronic-indemnity-form>. For participants aged 18 and under, the parents or guardian of such participant must

complete the indemnity form. Individuals who do not complete the indemnity form will not be allowed to participate in any activities at the venue or in connection with the Series.

- 3.10. All participants must provide a screenshot of the successfully submitted Microsoft form and Indemnity Form as proof of registration. Failure to submit the required screenshot may result in the registration being considered incomplete.
- 3.11. Participants under the age of 18, as of registration date, must be registered by a parent or legal guardian.
- 3.12. The Organisers reserve the right to refuse entry on-site of any participants at its discretion.
- 3.13. The Organisers reserve the right to conduct random identification checks on-site. Participants who fail to produce valid identification or do not meet the eligibility requirements may be refused entry at the Organisers' sole discretion.
- 3.14. Participants must comply with all venue rules, safety instructions, and directions issued by the Organisers and venue staff.
- 3.15. The Organisers may photograph, film, or otherwise record activities conducted during the Sessions. By joining the Sessions, you acknowledge and consent to the collection and use of your image, likeness, voice, and appearance in photographs, video recordings, and other media for general purposes (e.g. website, promotions and articles). Participants may request for the Organisers to stop using their images at any time.
- 3.16. The Organisers do not take responsibility or accept liability for damage, accident, or loss to any personal property or belongings. All items are left at the owner's sole risk.
- 3.17. No alterations or modifications to the venue or its property are permitted without prior written approval from The Kallang Group.

**Withdrawal, Postpone and Refunds Policy:**

- 3.18. All registrations, once confirmed, are strictly nonrefundable and nontransferable, under any circumstances.
- 3.19. Participants are responsible for ensuring that they meet the relevant age group and workshop eligibility criteria prior to registration. Participants who fail to meet the stated age requirements may be denied participation or entry without a refund.
- 3.20. No refunds/replacement shall be given if the participant wishes to withdraw from a Session for any reason. There shall be no refunds or make-up session if the participant misses a Session for any reason.
- 3.21. No refunds, credits, or exchanges will be provided due to nonattendance, late arrival, early departure, failure to meet eligibility requirements, or in the event of Session postponement, interruption, or cancellation arising from safety, weather, or unforeseen situations.
- 3.22. In the case of inclement weather prior to or during a Session, the Organisers will assess the situation and inform participants of any postponement accordingly. For safety reasons, participants may be advised to suspend or refrain from activities during

wet weather conditions. In the event of a lightning warning, all activities must cease immediately, even if it is not raining and may only resume once the warning has been officially lifted.

3.23. The Organisers reserves the right to postpone, cancel, interrupt, suspend, stop, or deny access to the venue(s) or Sessions without prior notice or compensation for reasons including, but not limited to, safety and security concerns, with venue conditions of entry, or scheduled or unforeseen circumstances.
